1. Choose one of the following characters to analyze. This will be the character that you write your essay on.

- B. Zach Powers
- C. Naomi Erlanger
- D. Sophie Donnelly
- E. Hugh Winkleman

2. On a full sheet of computer paper, draw out what that character looks like to you from what you read about them in Schooled.

3. Use these questions to guide your selection of quotes:

**Driving questions: Who am I? What makes a character real?**

Find multiple quotes that address the following (see picture below for placement):

- A. Head: What does the character think? (A, C)
- B. Mouth: What things do they say? How does what they say show who they are? (B, C)
- C. Heart: What does your character feel? (B, C)
- D. Feet: what actions does your character take? What do they do? (B, A)
